English Riding Lessons- Ages 8 and up

Group Lessons

Lessons consist of an average of 6 riders per group, organized with riders of similar ability. Available for children and adults. Children must be at least 8 years old. We offer lessons for beginner through advanced students teaching a balanced seat position. Lessons are 45 minutes long, same day and time each week, taught primarily in our indoor arena.

Valley Riding students who have taken pony camp, horse camp or Beginner Horsemanship may sign up for Beginner I.

Riders new to our program who have had English riding instruction at another facility or are not currently enrolled in a class at Rocky River Stables should consult with an instructor for appropriate placement.

WEIGHT LIMIT of 160 lbs. (A reasonable level of physical fitness is required for English Riding lessons.)

COST: \$280.00 for 10 weeks. Cash, checks payable to Valley Riding, Inc. or credit cards in person only. Only one make-up lesson will be given at the end of the session. Please give 24 hours notice in case of absence.

RIDING ATTIRE FOR ALL CLASSES: NO TENNIS SHOES! *Long pants*, hard soled shoes/boots with a low heel and riding hat **MUST BE WORN**. Riding hats may be borrowed from Valley Riding, Inc., and returned after each class. Gloves are desirable.

Refunds will be made if a class is filled, cancelled, or with a doctor's excuse. Attendance at class is the participants responsibility, Refunds will NOT be made because of non-attendance. *Valley Riding, Inc. reserves the right to reschedule or cancel classes should they not fill. Any class may be cancelled because of insufficient enrollment.*

Girl Scout/Boy Scout Riding Program

This program is two hours long. The first hour is spent in the arena in a beginning riding lesson. The second hour is spent touring the barn and learning basic horse care. Children must be at least 8 yrs. old and under 160 lbs. Minimum of 8 children required. Maximum 12 children. Please call for reservations, offered on Saturdays only.

Pony Camp - Ages 4 - 7

Children must weigh under 75 lbs. Campers learn general care and safety rules used in working around the ponies and in the barn. Each camper, with the aid of an assistant, helps clean their ponies before riding. Maximum 6 students. Riding Attire: **NO TENNIS SHOES!** Long pants, hard soled shoes/boots with a low heel and riding hat **MUST BE WORN**. Riding hats may be borrowed from Valley Riding, Inc., and returned after each class.

COST: \$175.00 for five 2-hour classes.
